PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

He has successfully first-chaired dozens of jury trials, bench trials, and private arbitrations in both construction disputes and complex litigation matters, in addition to presenting several oral arguments before the Nevada Supreme Court.

Governor Sandoval reappointed Mr. Ogilvie as chairman of the Commission in June 2013.
