She is actively involved with the Children's Attorneys Project through the Legal Aid Center of Southern Nevada, where she represents abused and neglected children who are placed in foster care. Mackenzie donated more than 200 hours of free legal work in 2018, and is a member of the 100 Pro Bono Hours Club Award.

Mackenzie graduated from the UNLV William S. Boyd School of Law, where she served as Notes Editor of the Nevada Law Journal, and active member of the Boyd School of Law Society of Advocates (Moot Court Team). Mackenzie was nominated by her law school peers to give the commencement speech alongside former Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid. She held clerkships with the Clark County Public Defender's Office and Justice Elissa F. Cadish of the Nevada Supreme Court.
