Kiley drafted all documents and argued key motions involved in the district court both setting aside the default judgment and granting a motion for judgment on the pleadings. After an appeal was taken, Kiley convinced the Nevada Supreme Court to dismiss the appeal.

Kiley's background includes serving as a Judicial Extern to the Honorable Andrew P. Gordon of the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada, a Judicial Extern to the Honorable Jennifer A. Dorsey of the U.S. District Court for the District of Nevada, a Judicial Extern for the Honorable Joanna S. Kishner of the Eighth Judicial District Court, Civil Division, in Las Vegas, a Summer Associate at McDonald Carano, and a law clerk in a boutique firm in Las Vegas.

Kiley finished law school in 2 ½ years, graduated *cum laude*, and received five CALI Awards for highest grades in Business Organizations, Negotiation, Antitrust, Family Law, and Comparative Gaming Law.
